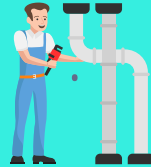

Journey to Homeownership

Teayha Webb first moved to City Heights in February, 2013. She had 3 children, ages 6, 15 and 22.

From the start, she and her family participated in HAC's support programs offered by the Resident Services Department. They included the GLASS (Get Learning and Start Succeeding) Program, the Teen Summer Work Program, and the Jobs Plus Program. Teayha and her family also took advantage of the volunteer opportunities with local faith-based agencies. Teayha believes by connecting with others, she was able to keep motivated and stay on track to achieve her goals.

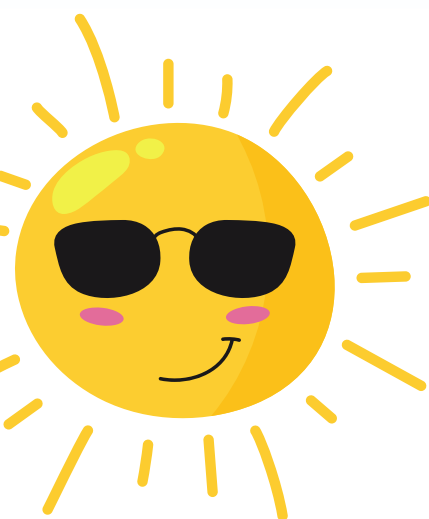
It was through the Jobs Plus program, and working with the Brighton Center, that Teayha's journey really took shape. She enrolled in the Brighton Center's Center for Employment Training (CET) and focused on obtaining certification in business computer technology. During her studies, Teayha also obtained employment with the Brighton Center as a Customer Service Specialist. She has maintained this employment for over 2 years.

Along the way, Teayha began to think about homeownership. At first, the idea scared her. She feared the responsibility of homeownership and high bills. However, she knew she wanted more. She really wanted a safe, permanent home.

Teayha enrolled in homeownership classes and sought the support of a financial coach. The financial coach helped her build a budget and provided the resources and support necessary to place her on the path to homeownership.

On February 19, 2023, Teayha moved into her own new home! She is now the proud homeowner of a cozy bungalow, in a quiet neighborhood in Covington. Her youngest attends John G Carlisle School and she is close to a bus line.

When asked what advice she might give others who are interested in homeownership, Teayha simply states, "When you see opportunities, take them!"
