 Never disassemble or try to make your own fireworks. • Don't point sparklers, or fireworks at yourself or others, especially when lighting them. Only light fireworks on the ground and in areas that are dry and fire-resistant. Don't attempt to ignite fireworks at the same time. Never allow young children to handle fireworks or sparklers to prevent fireworkrelated injuries. Always keep a portable fire extinguisher close by. Also, keep a water hose or buckets of water nearby to put out fires. If fireworks malfunction, don't relight them! Douse and soak malfunctioning fireworks with water then throw them away. Resist the urge to bring your dog to a fireworks display. The safest place for them is at home where it's familiar, guiet and not crowded. Never allow young children to handle fireworks or sparklers to prevent fireworkrelated injuries. Sparklers are hot enough to cause severe burns if mishandled. Instead of sparklers for your children, consider these alternatives: o Glow sticks o A confetti canon or poppers o Colorful streamers o Silly string o A light-up laser show or digital fireworks projection Always keep a portable fire extinguisher nearby close by. Also, keep a water hose or buckets of water nearby to put out fires. If fireworks malfunction, don't relight them! Douse and soak malfunctioning fireworks with water, then throw them away.
