INCOME CHANGES

All income changes must be reported within 7 days of the change. You can pick up a change form from your manager's office, main office, or complete a change at one of our Kiosks.

PEST CONTROL

It is important to report any pest issue to your property manager. It is equally as important to fully prepare for your treatments as indicated on the notice given stating what date the exterminator will be there. Being fully prepared, having a clean home, and allowing treatments is the most effective way in combating pests. Please review the pest control policy that was given out with June rent statements.

WINDOW AIR CONDITIONERS

This summer has sure been a scorcher with high heat and humidity. Please keep that in mind before you dial the temperature down on your a/c unit. When the humidity and temperatures are high, it causes the a/c's to run longer and harder to get the temperature that you have set, with most times never reaching the goal temp. The age, condition of the a/c, and if the filters and coils are dirty will also play a factor in how well the a/c functions. The harder the unit works, the more electricity it consumes.
